

## What can be rehomed?

Here is a list of items we most often get asked for and any safety information that pertains to it.

Items with mandatory standards are in green - please check your donation of any items in bold against our safety checklist. Please ensure that all clothing and linen is freshly laundered prior to donating.

Activity mats or play gyms
Bassinettes, cradles & moses
baskets

Baby clothing - 00000 (premmie) to size 2. All clothing should be freshly laundered and sorted by clothing size and bags labelled according to size and gender.

Baths (no stands)

Bottles & other feeding equipment

Bouncers or rockers - must have a 3 or 5 point safety harness intact and in working order

**Breastfeeding- specific pillows** 

Car restraints - capsules, reversible car seats with tether strap only. Must meet standard AS/NZ 1754. Must not be more than 8 years old and must never have been in an accident.

Change tables - must have roll-off protection such as a safety harness, and raised sides and ends at least 100mm high.

Carriers (i.e. Ergobaby) ergonomic design preferred Cots - Must meet standard AS/NZS 2172:2003 revised in 2005. Cots manufactured after January 2005. Please donate with the original manual and all the parts, screws, bolts, etc. secured in a ziplock bag and tape with clear/transparent tape to the base of the cot. If you can't find the manual, please email us the make and model, date of manufacture and photo to check it's suitable.

**Formula -** unopened tins only and within 3 months of expiring.

Highchairs - Must have a harness and be clean. Must meet standard AS/4684-2009. If you can't find this standard on the highchair please email us a photo.

Linen for cots and bassinettes -Flat & fitted sheets, blankets & mattress protectors, bunny rugs, swaddles and infant sleeping bags

**Manual breast pumps -** please ensure all parts are included.

Mattresses - cot mattresses must have a label with the dimensions printed, a date of manufacture of less than 10 years and be completely free of stains/damage. **Sterilisers -** microwave, not electric.

**Nappies -** brand new, unopened packets of disposables, or excellent condition cloth nappies.

Nappy bags and/or change mats

**Newborn head supports** 

Prams/Strollers - Must meet standard AS/NZS 2088:2000.
Must be able to recline fully as most requests are for newborns.
Must have 5 point harness, faultless brakes, sun hood and carry baskets. Please vaccum and clean before donating and please include original manuals if you have them.

Pram accessories like foot muffs, snugglers, newborn headrests, sunshades and raincovers (both single and double).

New Items - we welcome donations of new items of any of the above listed here, or any items included in our 'Baby Bundles' that are gifted to parents-inneed. To receive a list of the items included in a baby bundle, please email us.

## We do not rehome these items:

Anything electrical that plugs into mains power, including lamps, bottle warmers, baby monitors, sterilisers and electrical breast pumps.

**Foam booster seats.** We only rehome car restraints that have a tether strap.

**Portacots.** Portable cots are intended for temporary use and are not suitable for long term sleeping arrange-

**Strollers** that do not recline fully for newborns, or any lightweight travel strollers. If you are unsure, please email us with a photo and details to check.

Also: Baby walkers; bean bags; bumbo seats; sleeping hammocks; bath aids; pillows (other than breastfeeding pillows); highchairs that strap to chairs or hang from benches; change tables that sit on top of drawers; cot bumpers; jolly jumpers; bed rails; car seat H-harnesses; umbrella strollers; potties; toilet steps; portable travel chairs; foam floor mats; bath stands; cot mobiles; cushions; wall prints/hangings; safety gates; bikes; trikes; baby/toddler bike seats, scooters, helmets or ride on toys; preloved soft/stuffed toys require that washing in a machine to clean; baby/toddler books; toys requiring batteries; opened tins of formula; art & craft items; preloved baby towels; some baby carriers/slings (please email to check your brand); baby clothing over size 2; opened packets of nappies, nursing pads, sanitary pads or baby wipes; kids' tables and chairs; reusable/washable nursing pads; playpens; toddler beds.
