Olivia's Place Commits to Premises

Olivia's Place Pregnancy and Early Parenting Resource Centre has located suitable premises at the CBD end of Barkly St, Warragul. The organisation has committed to a two year lease agreement to commence in early October. Mrs Kirsten Finger, Coordinator of Olivia's Place, says that it's an exciting time for Olivia's Place, the staff of volunteers and for the community as a whole. "Our opening hours are yet to be confirmed, and is dependent upon volunteer availability, but we are aiming to be able to service local families during peak business hours – particularly for access to our planned parent facilities. Our plan is to provide access to parent facilities in early October, with an official opening date yet to be announced."

More volunteers may be needed to help staff the centre, and Mrs Finger is seeking expressions of interest from those with time to commit during the week. "This is a great time to get behind our organisation with our Project 500, ensuring our service provision into the future. We are also hoping that our upcoming Dinner & Fundraising Auction celebrating dads will give us a much needed financial boost to funds to ensure our service delivery across the 2 year lease period."
